The ball bounces around the wheel until it loses momentum and lands in one of the numbered pockets. The winning number and color correspond to the pocket where the ball rests.

The roulette layout is the playing field where players place their chips to make bets. The layout reflects all the possible bets players can make and is designed to correspond with the numbers and colors on the wheel.

The betting table consists of:

- **Numbers Grid:** A grid containing numbers 1 to 36 arranged in 12 rows and 3 columns, plus the 0 (and 00 in American roulette) positioned at the top.
- **Outside Bets Area:** Sections outside the main numbers grid for betting on groups of numbers or specific characteristics, such as

color or odd/even.

Types of Roulette Bets

- **Six Line Bet:** Betting on two adjacent rows, totaling six numbers, by placing a chip on the intersection of the two rows. Payout is 5 to 1.

Outside Bets

Outside bets cover larger groups of numbers and generally offer lower payouts but better odds of winning. These bets are placed on sections surrounding the numbers grid.

- **Red or Black:** Betting on the color of the winning number. Pays 1 to 1.
- **Odd or Even:** Betting on whether the winning number is odd or even. Pays 1 to 1.
- **Low or High:** Betting on whether the winning number will be in the lower half (1-18) or upper half (19-36). Pays 1 to 1.
- **Dozens:** Betting on one of the three groups of twelve numbers: 1-12, 13-24, or 25-36. Pays 2 to 1.
- **Columns:** Betting on one of the three vertical columns of twelve numbers each. Pays 2 to 1.

The Odds and House Edge

Each type of bet in roulette carries a different probability of winning. For example, a straight-up bet has a 1 in 37 chance in European roulette (because of the single zero), while outside bets like red or black nearly have a 50% chance of success.

The house edge is the built-in advantage that casinos maintain to ensure profitability over time. In European roulette, the house edge is approximately 2.7%, thanks to the single zero. American roulette, with the addition of the double zero, increases the house edge to about 5.26%, making it less favorable for players.
